FOCUS OF LEARNING FOR THE COURSE



This course focuses on the theory and practice of organisational change, teaching participants to identify organisational problems and design a plan for change based on an understanding of social science theories and models.

COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Effective change management requires skills of interpersonal communication, mediation, and negotiation. This course focuses on transforming discordant situations into opportunities for growth.

LEARNING METHODS

Strategies of learning will include discussion, lecture, role-playing, collaborative learning in small groups, guided meditations and creative activities (journaling, art).
