
The Soul of Leadership "Mini": Decision Making and Discernment

Studies indicate that one-half of managerial decisions fail. Pressure for quick decisions, the culture's overreliance on rational analysis, and the perceived need to appear decisive can impair a leader's ability to make good decisions. What are the habits necessary for cultivating successful decision-making? What does the ancient practice of discernment teach about drawing on one's whole self – heart, mind, soul, and spirit? What tools and support can leaders draw on to strengthen their leadership capacity, skill and success?

In this 10-week program, participants will:

- 1. Identify the times they have led with soul and learn how to do so more consistently.
- 2. Reflect on their own leadership experiences in light of the readings.
- 3. Learn to practice discernment in difficult leadership challenges.
- 4. Reflect on their own spiritual awareness and resources in relation to their particular leadership situations.
- 5. Learn to apply several leadership approaches and discern which is best for their own style and situation.
- 6. Experience community support and affirmation as they incorporate and develop new leadership skills.

We will meet in person twice – February 16 and April 24 (these will be day-long gatherings at Rolling Ridge Retreat Center in North Andover). In between, there will be three small group meetings, and online community.
